Operation Airdrop will join us at the Galaxy FBO/Conroe Airport to practice and train with pilots and plans for Emergency Supply Distribution and Safety. No Town left Behind and our community partner coalition will provide Ground Support Training and important tips for distributing supplies during disasters. “Practice supplies” will be donated to local, Fire, Police and Sheriff charities.

DAY 3: CHAINSAW SAFETY - ROAD CLEARING - DISASTER DRIVING OBSTACLE COURSE

The purpose of this campaign is to build national resilience by better preparing the public to save lives. By teaching basic skills to stop life threatening bleeding following everyday emergencies and natural disasters, communities are empower and lives are saved. Instructors will certify in the basics of packing funds and applying tourniquets.

We will be working on full-sized, remotely activated human simulators designed for point-of-injury, tactical medicine TRAINING for law enforcement, first responders, and civilian emergency response teams. In addition to receiving checklists, and helpful materials, participating will have the opportunity to walk around, board, load and unload private airplanes at the Galaxy FBO Hangers. No Town Left Behind will share our helpful Disaster Distribution Tips and How To's for responsible and smooth emergency deliveries. Supplies handled during our exercise will be donated to charities supported by local First Responders.

Operation Airdrop organizes with volunteers with private aircraft to deliver essential supplies in the wake of natural disasters.
